



Funkey Munkey Headband — Teacher Guide



Grade Levels: Pre-K – Grade 3

Activity Time: 15–25 minutes

Lesson Overview:

Students color, cut, and assemble their own Funkey Munkey Headband to practice fine-motor skills, direction following, measurement basics, and creativity.

Learning Objectives:

- Follow multi-step directions
- Demonstrate fine motor skills
- Express creativity
- Practice communication
- Apply measurement concepts

Standards Alignment:

Activity Instructions:

1. Color the monkey face and strips.
2. Cut out all pieces.
3. Measure and fit strips around head.
4. Glue or tape pieces together.
5. Wear and share designs.

Discussion Prompts:

- Why did you choose your colors?
- What makes Funkey Munkey kind or responsible?
- How did you measure your headband?

Extension Activities:

- Write about Funkey Munkey.
- Measure bands around objects.
- Discuss character traits.

Skills Reinforced:

Fine motor skills, following directions, creativity, collaboration, measurement reasoning.
